

Where did that Phrase come from?

The phrase 'to turn a blind eye' refers to a wilful refusal to acknowledge a particular reality, and dates back to the very early 19th century. During the 1801 Battle of Copenhagen where the British Navy were pitted against a large Danish-Norwegian fleet, the more conservative senior officer flagged one Horatio Nelson to withdraw... Supposedly Nelson brought his telescope to his blind eye and proclaimed that he saw no signal. He went on to score a decisive victory. Many have dismissed Nelson's famous quip as simply a battlefield myth, but the phrase to 'turn a blind eye' persists to this day.



Roy Stall Guest Speaker — 3 February New Norcia

Our Speaker Roy Stall was a student at one of the boarding schools in the 1950's and later was a casual Tour Guide for almost 15 years.

New Norcia is a town in Western Australia, 132 km north of Perth, near the Great Northern Highway. It is situated next to the banks of the Moore River, in the Shire of Victoria Plains. New Norcia is the only monastic town in Australia. A ground station for the European Space Agency is located 8 km south of the town. Founded in 1847 by Spanish Benedictine Monks, the town has had many purposes; a mission, a monastery, a provider of education and **and now as a** place of spiritual retreat.

The Monastery, where the monks live, work and pray, is at the heart of New Norcia. The monks of New Norcia live according to the guidance and rhythms of The Rule of St Benedict, which has been followed by monks since the sixth century AD. Monks who do so are referred to as 'Benedictines'. Unlike many priests and nuns, monks do not join an 'order' as such, but instead join an autonomous monastery where they promise to remain for the rest of their lives.

The New Norcia Hotel is a historic building in New Norcia, in Western Australia's Wheatbelt region. Part of the Benedictine Monastery Precinct, it opened in 1927 as a hostel for travellers and families of boarders at the New Norcia colleges, but later opened to the public. It closed in January 2020.
